



Register for 2014 Spring Wash Green-Up

Even though it feels like we skipped winter this year, spring is just around the corner. That means that it's also time to register for the Las Vegas Wash Coordination Committee's semi-annual **Wash Green-Up** volunteer planting event. The event is scheduled for **Saturday, March 15** and will re-vegetate a 10-acre area associated with the recently completed Duck Creek Confluence Weir construction project. With nearly 5,000 trees and shrubs to plant, the LWCC is looking for approximately **350** volunteers to devote a few hours to help revegetate the Las Vegas Wash to help reduce erosion and provide future habitat for wildlife.

Beginning at **noon**, all volunteers are offered a free barbecue lunch and commemorative T-shirt in appreciation for their service. Shovels, trowels, and gloves are also provided for use to assist with the planting. This event is always very popular with a high rate of repeat participants so it is strongly recommended to submit your registration early. Please visit lvwash.org to register and secure your spot.

New construction projects to begin



The Southern Nevada Water Authority recently awarded the contract for the Silver Bowl Weir and Archery Weir construction project to Las Vegas Paving. These two weirs will be the 18th and 19th weirs installed on the Las Vegas Wash to help curtail soil erosion. Construction is expected to begin in March 2014. The Bureau of Reclamation construction crew also is expected to arrive in February to help with some maintenance work on several of the existing weirs.
