Come help celebrate International Migratory Bird Day.

The event will take place at the Clark County In-Lieu Fee Mitigation Ponds and the trails and ponds adjacent to the Nature Center off Wetlands Park Drive.

The theme for this year's event is "Connecting people to bird conservation" and event organizers are taking it to heart.

Interested participants can reserve a one-hour time slot for observing birds at the Mitigation Ponds under the guidance and experience of several expert birders, providing a great opportunity to improve birding techniques such as species identification by sight and call. There also will be discussion on bird conservation and efforts made to improve bird habitat at the Clark County Wetlands Park.

In addition, participants will be able to wander the 80 acres near the Nature Center, known as the West 80, where several activities will take place for smaller birders, such as bird-themed story time, pine cone bird-feeder making, and several bird education tables with bird mounts, feathers and nests.

The hour-long time slots will run from **8:30 a.m. until noon** with the event concluding at **1 p.m.** To reserve a time slot with an expert birder, please call the Wetlands Park Visitor Center at **(702) 455-7522**. 
LVWash.org Member Website Undergoing Transition
